Functions of Anti Ragging Committee:

The function of Anti Ragging Committee (ARC) will monitor the anti ragging activity of the Institution, consider the recommendations of the Anti Ragging Squad and take appropriate decisions including spelling out suitable punishment to those found guilty.

- 1. To ensure compliance with the provisions of these Regulations and any law for the time being in force concerning ragging and to deal and act promptly with the incidents of ragging brought to its notice.*
- 2. To keep tabs on the happenings /events related to ragging in Campus or Off-campus within the hostels and other places in the college premises.*
- 3. To conduct such enquiry observing a fair and transparent procedure and the principals of natural justice and after giving adequate opportunity to the student or students accused of ragging and other witnesses to place before it the facts, documents and views concerning the incident of ragging, and considering such other relevant information as may be required.*
- 4. To monitor, direct and oversee the functions and performance of the Anti-Ragging Squads in prevention and curbing of ragging in the institution.*

Functions and Duties of the Anti Ragging Squad:

- 1. To be vigilant at all hours including at odd hours all around the Campus and other places vulnerable to incidents of, and having the potential of, ragging and shall be empowered to inspect such places.*
- 2. Conduct anonymous random surveys among freshers to check whether the Campus is indeed free from ragging.*

3. To conduct an on-the-spot enquiry into any incident of ragging referred to it by the Head of the institution or any member of the faculty or any member of the staff or any student or any parent or guardian or any employee of a service provider or by any other person, as the case may be: and the enquiry report along with recommendations shall be submitted to the Anti-Ragging Committee for action.

4. To ensure the display of posters/tabs on Main and Departmental Notice Boards and other places such as canteen, Library, Sports Lounge, Gymnasium, Bus stops and other prominent designated places.

5. Also to monitor the welfare of fresh students outside the campus;

6. Any other activity the Anti Ragging Committee might delegate to the Squad.

➤ **Actions to be taken against students for indulging and abetting ragging in technical institutions Universities including Deemed to be University imparting technical education:-**

1. *The punishment to be meted out to the persons indulged in ragging has to be exemplary and justifiably harsh to act as a deterrent against recurrence of such incidents.*
2. *Every single incident of ragging a First Information Report (FIR) must be filed without exception by the institutional authorities with the local police authorities.*
3. *The Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution shall take an appropriate decision, with regard to punishment or otherwise, depending on the facts of each incident of ragging and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging.*
4. *a) Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following:-*
 - (i) Cancellation of admission*
 - (ii) Suspension from attending classes*
 - (iii) Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits*
 - (iv) Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process*
 - (v) Withholding results*
 - (vi) Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.*
 - (vii) Suspension/expulsion from the hostel*
 - (viii) Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters*
 - (ix) Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.*
 - (x) Collective punishment: when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.**b) An appeal against the order of punishment by the Anti-Ragging Committee shall lie,*
 - i. In case of an order of an institution, affiliated to or constituent part, of the University, to the Vice-Chancellor of the University;*
 - ii. In case of an order of a University, to its Chancellor.*
 - iii. In case of an institution of national importance created by an Act of Parliament, to the Chairman or Chancellor of the institution, as the case may be.*
5. *The institutional authorities shall intimate the incidents of ragging occurred in their premises along with actions taken to the Council form time to time.*
